- Snot outlines
- Pens + pencils
- Scissors
- Blu tac or glue

OUTCOME

Fun way for young people to share views on what they want improved.



Draw a large picture of a miserable face with a cold (or print out the outline provided) on A3 paper.

In small groups of 4-5 ask the young people to think about what is not fair about a subject that has been chosen by the Leaders, or the young people. Ask the group to write their thoughts on green 'snot-shaped' paper and stick them all over the miserable face.

This activity can be used to find out what the group don't like about a programme, meeting night, camp, or something outside of Scouting that you want to lead up to talk about, eg. an earthquake, civil war, or refugees. The topic should be appropriate to the age group.

Now turn this into a positive activity by discussing how the things identified as 'snot fair' could be done better and allow everyone to have their voices heard.
